Version 1.1.1 Release Notes

Installation

Drag & Drop the **Screen Saver Menu** to your desired installation location, we recommend the Utilities folder. Once installed, double-click the application to initially launch. A new menu item will appear in your main menu bar, this is the **Screen Saver Menu** utility, explore the "Preferences..." to see what your favorite settings are.

You can either add the **Screen Saver Menu** to your Login Items manually or by using the application preferences to automatically launch the application when you log in.

Shareware

The **Screen Saver Menu** is a shareware application and is fully-functional throughout the 60 day trial period, after which some features are disabled until registration is obtained.

Registration

Why register? To fully activate your software by stopping all reminders and enabling all features. It also helps support us, as developers, in continuing to improve this and other applications.
